GENERAL CONDITIONS

Competition will be conducted under the General Rules and By- Laws of Swimming Queensland. The Meet is open to all SQ registered swimmers and other swimmers who meet clearance criteria.

Age group of competitors for the Meet is the age as at the first day of competition (i.e. 3 July 2026).

Athletes cannot swim 'up' an age in individual events.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This swim meet contains only "Timed Finals" type events. Heats/Events may be amalgamated at the discretion of the Referee and/or Meet Director.

Multiclass swimmers may compete in both able-body and multiclass events; however, each swimmer can only accumulate points in one (1) discipline of their choice.

AGE AGGREGATE & RUNNER-UP AWARDS

Age Aggregate & Runner-up prizes will be awarded to the following: 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15Yrs & Over and MC.

AGE AGGREGATE POINTS – SATURDAY SESSION ONLY

The following events only will qualify for points towards Age Champion & Runner Up:

MC: 4 x 50m MC events

8-10 Years: 4 x 50m events + 100m IM

11–15 Years & Over: 4 x 100m events + 200m IM

The points system used will be as follows:

1st to 16th: 35, 30, 26, 23, 20, 17, 14, 11, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

In the event of a tie, the swimmer who has the fastest combined overall time in the age champion events will be the winner.

AWARDS/MEDALS – 8 & Over

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd for all events (excluding Distance events 400m, 800m & 1500m).

All Age Champion Events (excluding MC) are Multi Aged, all other events are combined events and awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd places overall.

AWARDS/MEDALS – 7 & Under

Swimmers aged 7 and under will receive a participation award

DISTANCE EVENTS – 400m, 800m & 1500m

Cash prizes will be awarded as:

1st - \$30, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$20

PLEASE NOTE:

All refund requests will be considered giving consideration to the timing of the request and written reasons provided.

The decision of the Meet Director in this respect will be final.

Please note that due to recent changes to Child Safety Legislation all attending Clubs must collate a roster of all their timekeepers for this Swim Meet. The roster must include the timekeeper's name, address and phone number.

A copy of this roster must be kept by the Club and supplied to Biloela Swimming Club upon request.
